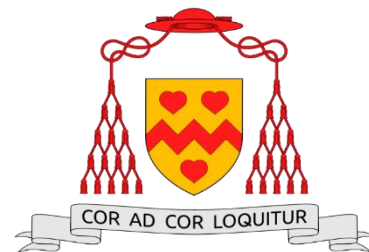

### Our Online Offer

#### May to June 'Primary Teacher and Secondary School Liaison'

#### Week commencing 2 May – Welcome Letter & Data Collection Sheets

We will launch an electronic questionnaire to ascertain who (where possible) pupils would like to be with in their form groups and find out a little more information.



#### Monday Evening 20 June – Parent & Pupil Interviews

We will conduct virtual interviews with parents and pupils using 'SchoolCloud', our video parents' evening software. You will have an opportunity to speak to a member of staff and let us know everything we need to about your child.

## **Monday 20 June – Team Building Day**
