

## **WHAT IS THE 16-19 TUITION FUND?**

The 16-19 fund is additional funding that has been provided to St John Henry Newman Catholic School to ensure we support all 16-19 learners who have had their learning disrupted by the COVID -19 lockdown. The fund will be used for small group and 1:1 tuition in English, Maths and vocational learning for 16 to 19-year-old learners. This tuition will be in addition to the planned study programme hours.

## **WHO CAN BE SUPPORTED BY THIS FUND?**

Students who are on a 16 to 19 study programme and have had their learning disrupted in the 2019 to 2020 academic year from the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. Additionally, regard will be given to the needs of students with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND), particularly where they have experienced additional disruption to learning as a result of their specific needs and disabilities,

## **HOW IS ST JOHN HENRY NEWMAN USING THIS FUND?**

We will use this fund to provide small group/(Maximum of five per group) and 1:1 tuition to learners both online and face to face. These sessions will be developed in a bespoke way to meet the individual needs of every learner. The tuition sessions will be scheduled in addition to the planned programme of study hours already timetabled for the academic year 2020/21.
