## Newman Uniform – YEARS 7 - 11

The uniform will identify Newman students as proud members of the school and community. At all times students are to wear the uniform with pride and respect for all that it represents. (The full uniform is to be worn by students on the way to school, between lessons and on the way home).

<b>Socks</b>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Plain black socks	
<b>Shoes</b>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Black polishable school-type shoes with a distinct heel and not flat soled.	Boots, fashion shoes, trainers and trainer-type/canvas shoes are not to be worn.
<b>Shirt</b>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Plain white school shirt. Shirts need to have sufficient length to enable them to be easily tucked into the students' trousers	Available from high street retailers.
<b>Sweater</b>	Optional. Burgundy v-necked with embroidered school badge. These can be purchased from supplier. Only the school sweater may be worn in school	These can be purchased from designated supplier.

<b>Outdoor coat</b>	Coats/jackets must be plain black with no designer logos and should not be worn in classrooms or school buildings at any time.	Hoodies, designer tops, denim, denim-look, leather or leather-look garments are not to be worn. Coats to be kept in lockers.
<b>School Bag</b>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> An appropriate school bag.	Bags should be large enough to hold A4 books and appropriate equipment, they must be brought to school every day.

<b>Blazer</b>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Black school blazer with embroidered school badge	To be purchased from school's designated supplier.
<b>Trousers</b>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Approved black school trousers. These should be smart fitting with concealed zips. Black socks are to be worn with trousers. Black leggings are not acceptable.	Styles of standard school trousers are available from high street retailers.
<b>Skirt</b>	Or Black school knee-length school skirt – not lycra.	Available from high street retailers.
<b>Tights</b>	Plain opaque black tights.	Available from high street retailers.
<b>Shoes</b>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Black polishable school-type shoes with a distinct heel and not flat soled.	Boots, fashion shoes, trainers and trainer-type/canvas shoes are not to be worn.
<b>Shirt</b>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Plain white school shirt. Shirts need to have sufficient length to enable them to be easily tucked into the students' trousers.	Available from high street retailers.
<b>Sweater</b>	Optional. Burgundy v-necked with embroidered school badge. These can be purchased from supplier. Only the school sweater may be worn in school	These bear the school badge and are only available from school supplier.
<b>Tie</b>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> School "clip on" ties	These can be purchased from supplier.
<b>Outdoor coat</b>	Coats/jackets must be plain black with no designer logos and should not be worn in classrooms or school buildings at any time.	Hoodies, designer tops, denim, denim-look, leather or leather-look garments are not to be worn. Coats to be kept in lockers.
<b>School Bag</b>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> An appropriate school bag.	Bags should be large enough to hold A4 books and appropriate equipment, they must be brought to school every day.

- Jewellery: a wrist watch can be worn. One set of small stud earrings. No facial or body piercings. No stretchers/spacers.
  - Make-up should be subtle and not be excessive. False eyelashes, heavy mascara/eyeliner, heavy lipstick, drawn on eyebrows are unacceptable.
  - Hair styles should not be shaven or extreme and hair can only be one natural colour. Tramlines/patterns and dipped dyed hair are not allowed. Hair accessories should be for tying back long hair and should be subtle.
  - Nail varnish should be clear or pale, a natural consistent colour. Acrylic/gel/nail art or vivid colours are not acceptable. False nails/nail extensions/acrylics are not permitted for health and safety reasons.
